Sales Department Meeting Report

We reviewed the sales figures for the past quarter. We are currently experiencing a significant dip in sales in our hair care products. This has been going on since the beginning of the year when we introduced the improved version of our top-selling hair care line, *Catherine's Curls*. Our advertising has not been successful in convincing more consumers to buy these products. We know there is a market for products such as these manufactured with 100% natural ingredients and no testing on animals. In fact, our competitors are doing quite well in this area and have been for a number of years. Lithuania, the Czech Republic, and Romania have announced a comprehensive plan for free trade. It is being portrayed as an opportunity for greater economic growth for all three nations.
